



Orange Slice Cowl

Supplies:

- Lion Brand Hometown USA Syracuse Orange (or other super bulky weight yarn), small amount
- Lion Brand Jiffy Dark Grey Heather (or other bulky weight yarn), 1 ball
- Size 11 needles (8mm)
- Size 8 needles (5mm)
- Large eye tapestry needle

Gauge: 3 stitches and 5 rows per inch (bulky yarn in moss stitch on the size 8 needles)

Abbreviations:

- k - knit
- p - purl
- ws - wrong side
- rs - right side

With the orange yarn and size 11 needles, cast on 9 stitches.

Row 1 (ws): (p1, k1)4x, p1

Row 2 (rs): (k1, p1)4x, k1

Repeat rows 1 and 2 four more times.

Repeat row 1 one more time. Bind off.

With the grey yarn, pick up and knit 12 stitches along one side of the orange piece. (Along a side not the top or bottom). Work these stitches in seed stitch.

Row 1 (ws): (k1, p1)6 times

Row 2 (rs): (p1, k1)6 times

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for desired length. My cowl is 45" total, 3 inches of orange and 42" of grey.

Bind off the grey and seam to the other side of the orange slice. Weave in ends. Block if desired.

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
