



Frozen Mittens Adult

Size: Women's medium (7.5 inches)

Supplies:

- Fingering weight yarn - Blue - 210 yards (about 44 grams) White - 110 yards (about 23 grams) (I used Knit Picks Palette in Cyan and White)
- Four size 1 (2.25 mm) double-pointed needles (or size needed to get gauge)
- Stitch markers
- Scrap fingering weight yarn
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 10 stitches and 12 rows per inch

Abbreviations:

- K - knit
- P - purl
- M1 - make one, direction doesn't matter
- M1r - make one right
- M1l - make one left
- Ssk - slip, slip, knit
- K2tog - knit two stitches together

Follow the written pattern for shaping instructions and the chart for the color pattern. Switch which side of the pattern you do first to make the opposite hand.

Cuff:

Cast on 72 stitches. Divide between three needles. Join together to knit in the round being careful not to twist the stitches. Place a stitch marker between the last and first stitch to mark rows.

Row 1 -12: k1, p1 until end of row

Row 13 - 34: k

Hand:

Row 35: k24, m1, k24, m1, k24, m1 (75 stitches)

Row 36: k37, m1l, k1, m1r, k37 (77 stitches) (You may want to place stitch markers before the m1l and after the m1r to help mark the thumb gusset.)

Row 37: k

Row 38: k37, m1l, k3, m1r, k37 (79 stitches)

Row 39: k

Row 40: k37, m1l, k5, m1r, k37 (81 stitches)

Row 41: k
Row 42: k37, m1l, k7, m1r, k37 (83 stitches)
Row 43: k
Row 44: k37, m1l, k9, m1r, k37 (85 stitches)
Row 45: k
Row 46: k37, m1l, k11, m1r, k37 (87 stitches)
Row 47: k
Row 48: k37, m1l, k13, m1r, k37 (89 stitches)
Row 49: k
Row 50: k37, m1l, k15, m1r, k37 (91 stitches)
Row 51: k
Row 52: k37, m1l, k17, m1r, k37 (93 stitches)
Row 53: k
Row 54: k37, m1l, k19, m1r, k37 (95 stitches)
Row 55: k
Row 56: k37, m1l, k21, m1r, k37 (97 stitches)
Row 57: k
Row 58: k37, m1l, k23, m1r, k37 (99 stitches)
Row 59: k
Row 60: k37, m1l, k25, m1r, k37 (101 stitches)
Row 61: k
Row 62: k37, m1l, k27, m1r, k37 (103 stitches)
Row 63 – 65: k
Row 66: k37, put the next 29 stitches on a piece of scrap yarn, cast on one stitch, k37 (74 stitches on the needles, 29 on the yarn)
Row 67: k36, k2tog, k37 (74 stitches)
Row 68 – 106: k
Row 107: ssk, k33, k2tog, ssk, k33, k2tog (70 stitches)
Row 108: k
Row 109: ssk, k31, k2tog, ssk, k31, k2tog (66 stitches)
Row 110: k
Row 111: ssk, k29, k2tog, ssk, k29, k2tog (62 stitches)
Row 112: k
Row 113: ssk, k27, k2tog, ssk, k27, k2tog (58 stitches)
Row 114: ssk, k25, k2tog, ssk, k25, k2tog (54 stitches)
Row 115: ssk, k23, k2tog, ssk, k23, k2tog (50 stitches)
Row 116: ssk, k21, k2tog, ssk, k21, k2tog (46 stitches)
Row 117: ssk, k19, k2tog, ssk, k19, k2tog (42 stitches)
Row 118: ssk, k17, k2tog, ssk, k17, k2tog (38 stitches)
Row 119: ssk, k15, k2tog, ssk, k15, k2tog (34 stitches)
Row 120: ssk, k13, k2tog, ssk, k13, k2tog (30 stitches)
Row 121: ssk, k11, k2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog (26 stitches)
Row 122: ssk, k9, k2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog (22 stitches)
Row 123: ssk, k7, k2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog (18 stitches)

Cut the yarn leaving about a 12" tail. Put the front stitches on one needle and the back on another. Seam the top of the mitten with the Kitchener stitch.

Thumb:

Put the 29 stitches on the scrap yarn on three needles. Pick up two stitches from the hand and place a stitch marker after them to mark rows. 31 stitches on the needles.

Row 66: k29, k2tog (30 stitches)

Row 67 – 88: k

Row 89: ssk, k11, k2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog (26 stitches)

Row 90: k

Row 91: ssk, k9, k2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog (22 stitches)

Row 92: ssk, k7, k2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog (18 stitches)

Row 93: ssk, k5, k2tog, ssk, k5, k2tog (14 stitches)

Row 94: ssk, k3, k2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog (10 stitches)

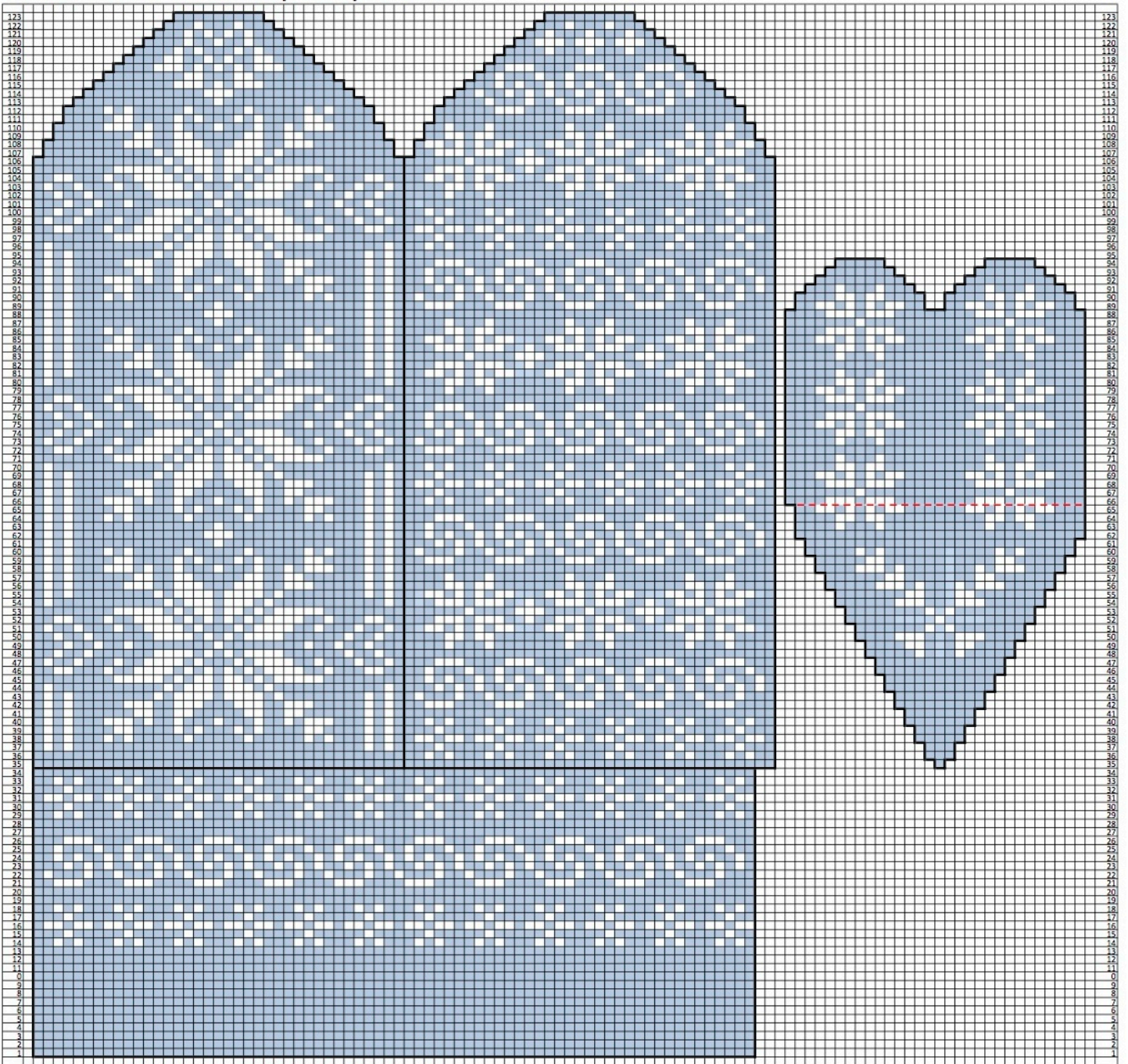
Cut the yarn leaving about a 12" tail. Put the front stitches on one needle and the back on another. Seam the top of the mitten with the Kitchener stitch.

Weave in all ends.
