

Hjärtan och Blommor Mittens

Size: Women's Large (8 inches wide) or Medium (7.5 inches wide)

Supplies:

- Approx. 69g/320yds fingering weight yarn. 42g/195yds MC, 27g/125yds CC based on large size (I used Knit Picks Palette in Pool and Serrano.)
- Four size 1 double-pointed needles (or size needed to get gauge)
- Scrap fingering weight yarn (a contrasting color makes your life easier)
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 10 stitches and 12 rows per inch (It is important to get gauge to get the stated size.)

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

M1 - Make 1 direction doesn't matter

Ssk – slip, slip, knit

K2tog – knit two together

Follow chart for colorwork and written pattern for shaping.

Pattern:

Stitch numbers for the medium size are in parenthesis when different.

With MC cast on 78 (72) stitches. Divide between three needles and join together to knit in the round being careful not to twist stitches. Place a stitch marker between the first and last stitch to mark rows.

Row 1: (Latvian braid set-up row) k

Row 2: (First Latvian braid row) Bring both yarns to the front with the MC on top. P with MC, bring CC over MC and p, bring MC over CC and p. Continue until end of row.

Row 3: (Second Latvian braid row) Bring MC under CC and p, bring CC under MC and p. Continue until end of row. Bring both yarns to the back.

(If you want the braid on the second mitten to point in the opposite direction switch the order in which you do rows 2 and 3.)

Row 4: k20(18), m1, k19(18), m1, k20(18), m1, k19(18), m1 (82(76) stitches)

Row 5 – 66: k

Row 67: (Right hand) k46(42), knit the next 15 stitches onto the scrap yarn, put those 15 stitches back on the left needle, k36(34)

Row 67: (Left hand) k62(58), knit the next 15 stitches onto the scrap yarn, put those stitches back on the left needle, k20(18)

Row 68 – 109: k

Large Only:

Row 110: k1, ssk, k35, k2tog, k2, ssk, k35, k2tog, k1 (78 stitches)
Row 111 – 112: k
Row 113: k1, ssk, k33, k2tog, k2, ssk, k33, k2tog, k1 (74 stitches)
Row 114 – 115: k
Row 116: k1, ssk, k31, k2tog, k2, ssk, k31, k2tog, k1 (70 stitches)
Row 117: k
Row 118: k1, ssk, k29, k2tog, k2, ssk, k29, k2tog, k1 (66 stitches)
Row 119: k
Row 120: k1, ssk, k27, k2tog, k2, ssk, k27, k2tog, k1 (62 stitches)
Row 121: k1, ssk, k25, k2tog, k2, ssk, k25, k2tog, k1 (58 stitches)
Row 122: k1, ssk, k23, k2tog, k2, ssk, k23, k2tog, k1 (54 stitches)
Row 123: k1, ssk, k21, k2tog, k2, ssk, k21, k2tog, k1 (50 stitches)
Row 124: k1, ssk, k19, k2tog, k2, ssk, k19, k2tog, k1 (46 stitches)
Row 125: k1, ssk, k17, k2tog, k2, ssk, k17, k2tog, k1 (42 stitches)
Row 126: k1, ssk, k15, k2tog, k2, ssk, k15, k2tog, k1 (38 stitches)
Row 127: k1, ssk, k13, k2tog, k2, ssk, k13, k2tog, k1 (34 stitches)
Row 128: k1, ssk, k11, k2tog, k2, ssk, k11, k2tog, k1 (30 stitches)

Medium Only:

Row 110: ssk, k36, ssk, k36 (74 stitches)
Row 111: k
Row 112: ssk, k33, k2tog, ssk, k33, k2tog (70 stitches)
Row 113: k
Row 114: ssk, k31, k2tog, ssk, k31, k2tog (66 stitches)
Row 115: k
Row 116: ssk, k29, k2tog, ssk, k29, k2tog (62 stitches)
Row 117: k
Row 118: ssk, k27, k2tog, ssk, k27, k2tog (58 stitches)
Row 119: ssk, k25, k2tog, ssk, k25, k2tog (54 stitches)
Row 120: ssk, k23, k2tog, ssk, k23, k2tog (50 stitches)
Row 121: ssk, k21, k2tog, ssk, k21, k2tog (46 stitches)
Row 122: ssk, k19, k2tog, ssk, k19, k2tog (44 stitches)
Row 123: ssk, k17, k2tog, ssk, k17, k2tog (40 stitches)
Row 124: ssk, k15, k2tog, ssk, k15, k2tog (36 stitches)

Seam together using Kitchener stitch.

Thumb (both sizes):

Carefully remove the scrap yarn placing the 15 lower stitches on one needle and the upper 15 on another. Divide between three needles placing a stitch maker between the last stitch of the upper stitches and the first stitch of the lower stitches to mark rows.

Row 67: k15, pick up and knit one stitch (I often will pick up 2 stitches and knit them together to prevent a hole, that is your choice.), k15, pick up and knit one stitch (32 stitches)
Row 68 – 93: k
Row 94: ssk, k11, k2tog, k1, ssk, k11, k2tog, k1 (28 stitches)
Row 95: ssk, k9, k2tog, k1, ssk, k9, k2tog, k1 (24 stitches)
Row 96: ssk, k7, k2tog, k1, ssk, k7, k2tog, k1 (20 stitches)

Row 97: ssk, k5, k2tog, k1, ssk, k5, k2tog, k1 (16 stitches)

Row 98: ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1 (12 stitches)

Row 99: ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1 (8 stitches)

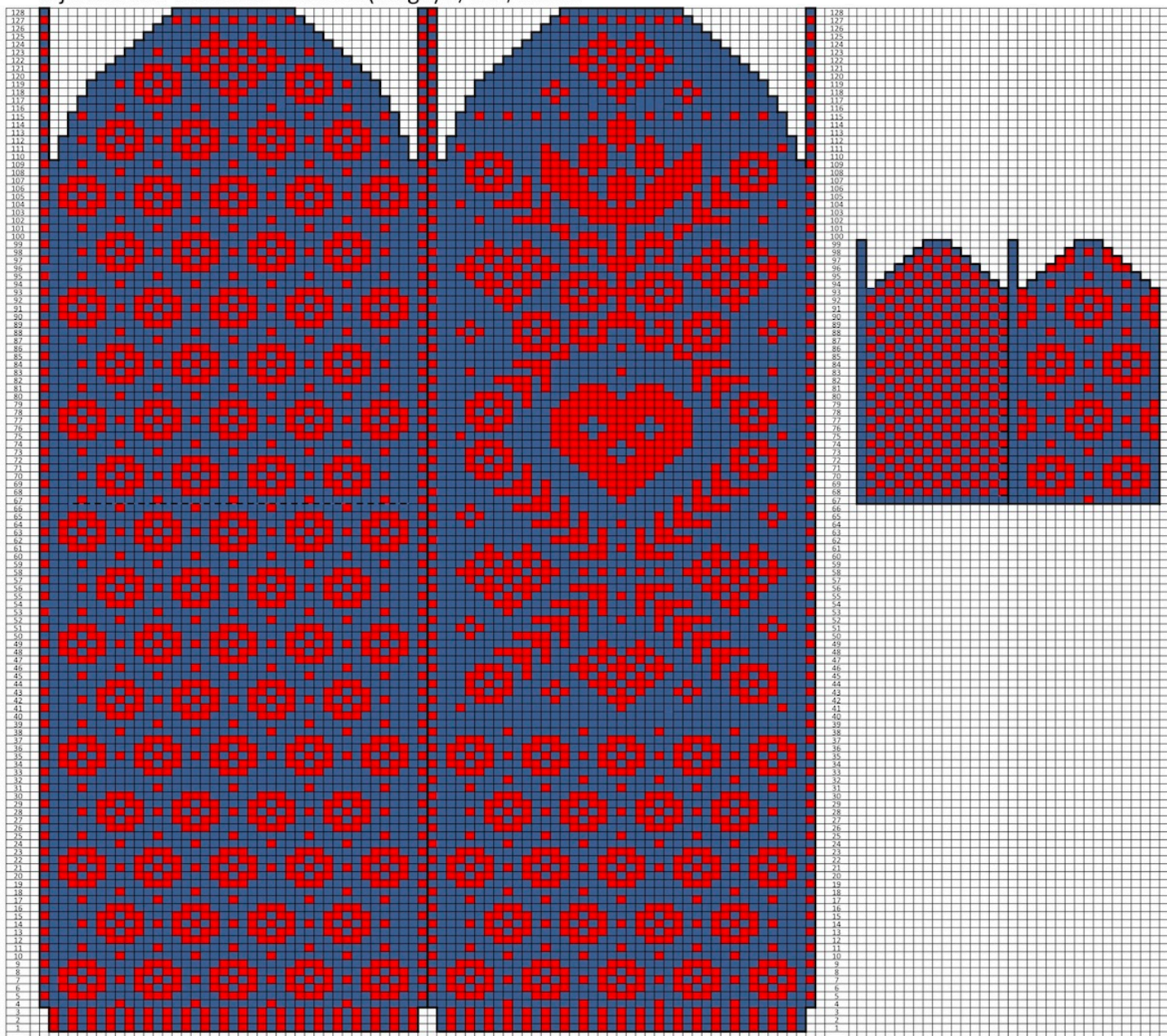
Seam together using Kitchener stitch or weave the tail through all the stitches and pull tight.

Weave in ends.

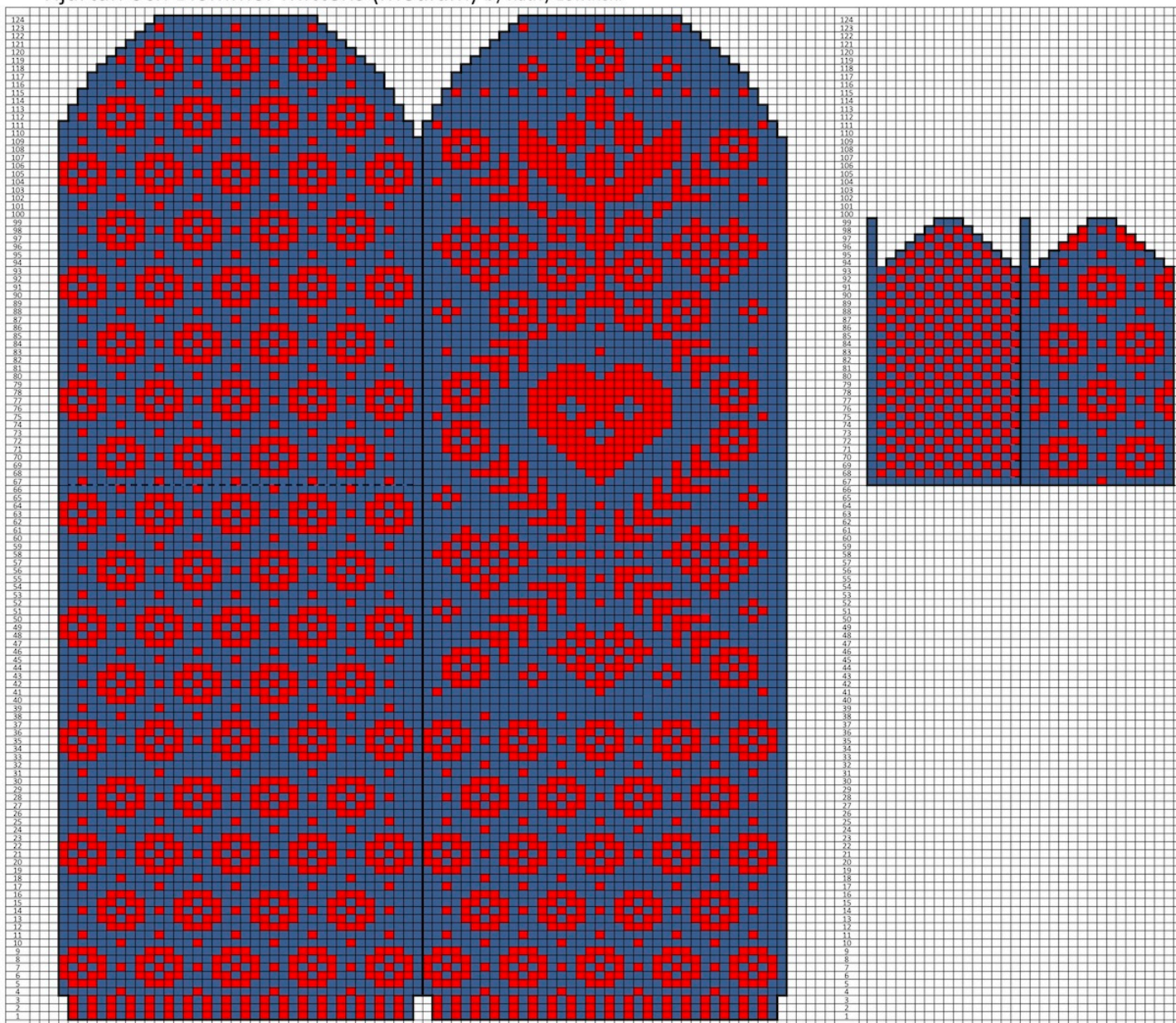
