



Cornwall Spring

Size: 7.4" wide x 7.5" long, not including 2.5" cuff. (It is important to get gauge to get the stated size.)

To make a mitten that is closer to 7" long skip rows 37 – 40. Move the thumb up as needed, probably four rows.

Gauge: 10 stitches and 12 rows per inch (It is important to get gauge to get the stated size.)

Supplies:

- 303yds/65g fingering weight yarn, 135 yds/29g for MC, 47yds/10g dark green, 52yds/11g medium green, 42yds/9g light green and 27yds/6g blue. I used Knit Picks Palette in Cream, Clover, Edamame, Green Tea, and Koigu KPPPM P839.
- Four size 1 double-pointed needles or size needed to get gauge
- Stitch marker
- Scrap fingering yarn
- Tapestry needle

Abbreviations:

k – knit

p – purl

ssk – slip, slip, knit

k2tog – knit two stitches together

m1 – make one stitch, direction doesn't matter

Follow the written pattern for shaping and the chart for color work.

Cuff:

Cast on 70 stitches. Divide between three needles and join together to knit in the round. Place a stitch marker between the last and first stitch to mark rows.

Row 1 – 6: p

Row 7: Create hemmed edge by picking up a cast on stitch with each stitch and purling them together.

Row 8 – 35: k

Hand:

Row 36: k17, m1, k18, m1, k17, m1, k18, m1 (74 stitches) (You can do whatever increase you like instead of m1.)

Row 37 - 67: k

Row 68:

Right hand: k5, k the next 15 stitches onto the waste yarn, move those 15 stitches back to the left needle, k54 with working yarn

Left hand: k17, k the next 15 stitches onto the waste yarn, move those 15 stitches back to the left needle, k42 with working yarn

Row 69 - 111: k
Row 112: ssk, k33, k2tog, ssk, k33, k2tog (70 stitches)
Row 113: k
Row 114: ssk, k31, k2tog, ssk, k31, k2tog (66 stitches)
Row 115: k
Row 116: ssk, k29, k2tog, ssk, k29, k2tog (62 stitches)
Row 117: k
Row 118: ssk, k27, k2tog, ssk, k27, k2tog (58 stitches)
Row 119: ssk, k25, k2tog, ssk, k25, k2tog (54 stitches)
Row 120: ssk, k23, k2tog, ssk, k23, k2tog (50 stitches)
Row 121: ssk, k21, k2tog, ssk, k21, k2tog (46 stitches)
Row 122: ssk, k19, k2tog, ssk, k19, k2tog (42 stitches)
Row 123: ssk, k17, k2tog, ssk, k17, k2tog (38 stitches)
Row 124: ssk, k15, k2tog, ssk, k15, k2tog (34 stitches)
Row 125: ssk, k13, k2tog, ssk, k13, k2tog (30 stitches)

Put front 15 stitches on one needles and back 15 on another. Seam together using Kitchener stitch.

Thumb:

Put the stitches above and below the waste yarn on needles carefully removing the waste yarn.

Row 68: K 11 stitches from the bottom of the thumb onto one needle. On needle two, k the next 4 stitches, pick up two stitches from the hand of the mitten and knit them together, k 6 stitches from the top of the thumb. On needle three, knit the next 9 stitches, pick up two stitches from the hand of the mitten and knit them together. Place stitch marker to mark rounds. (32 stitches)

Row 69 – 94: k

Row 95: ssk, k12, k2tog, ssk, k12, k2tog (28 stitches)

Row 96: k

Row 97: ssk, k10, k2tog, ssk, k10, k2tog (24 stitches)

Row 98: ssk, k8, k2tog, ssk, k8, k2tog (20 stitches)

Row 99: ssk, k6, k2tog, ssk, k6, k2tog (16 stitches)

Row 100: ssk, k4, k2tog, ssk, k4, k2tog (12 stitches)

Put front 6 stitches on one needle and back 6 on another. Seam together using Kitchener stitch.

Weave in ends and block.

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
