

Bloomin' Happy Mittens

Clue 4 - 7" Wide Version by Kathy Lewinski

Follow the chart for color changes and the written directions for shaping.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

K2tog – knit two together

Kfb – knit front and back

M1l – make one left

M1r – mark one right

P – purl

Rnd(s) – Round(s)

Ssk – slip, slip, knit

Color Notes:

Continue the color as you did in clue 2. On the top of the peasant thumb there are flowers, if you worked the flowers on the palm in your CC2 it would be cute to do it here too.

Thumbs:

The thumb is approximately 2.5" long. If you would like a 2" thumb start the decreases on rnd 76. On the peasant thumb version, do the flower tops on the second full petals. On the side-gore version, skip the two top smaller circles on the left side of the chart.

Peasant Thumb Version:

On the first rnd, you are picking up stitches on either side of the thumb. If you like, you can pick up two stitches on each side and knit them together on rnd. 58 to prevent larger holes.

Put the 15 stitches above the waste yarn and the 15 stitches below the waste yarn on two needles. Carefully remove the waste yarn. Divide the 30 stitches between three needles. Place a stitch marker on the right side between the top and bottom stitches to mark rnds.

Rnd 57: k15, pick up and knit one stitch from the hand, k15, pick up and knit one stitch from the hand (32 stitches)

Side-Gore Thumb Version:

On the first rnd you are picking up a stitch from the hand of the mitten. If you like, you can pick up two stitches and knit them together on rnd. 58 to prevent a larger hole.

Put the 31 stitches on the waste yarn in three needles. Place a stitch marker where the thumb meets the mitten to mark rnds.

Rnd 57: k31, pick up and knit one stitch from the hand. (32 stitches)

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Both Thumb Versions:

Rnds 58 – 81: k

Rnd 82: ssk, k12, k2tog, ssk, k12, k2tog (28 stitches)

Rnd 83: ssk, k10, k2tog, ssk, k10, k2tog (24 stitches)

Rnd 84: ssk, k8, k2tog, ssk, k8, k2tog (20 stitches)

Rnd 85: ssk, k6, k2tog, ssk, k6, k2tog (16 stitches)

Rnd 86: ssk, k4, k2tog, ssk, k4, k2tog (12 stitches)

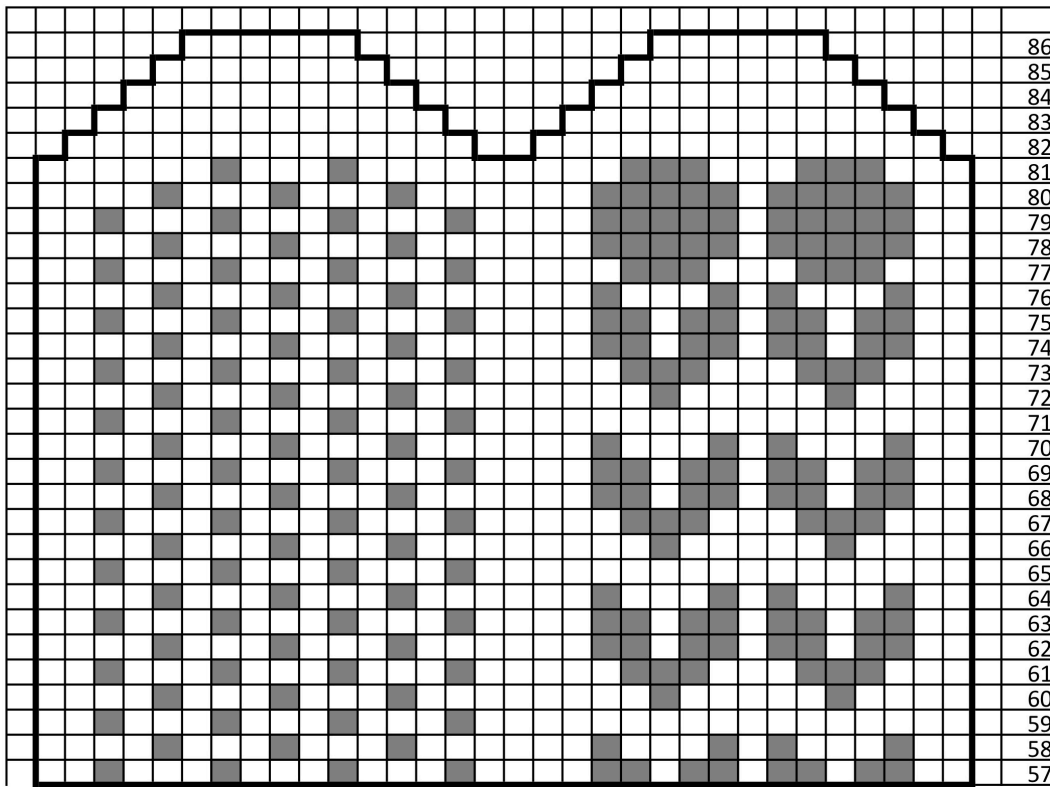
Put the first 6 stitches on one needle and the second 6 on another. Seam with Kitchener stitch.

Weave in ends.

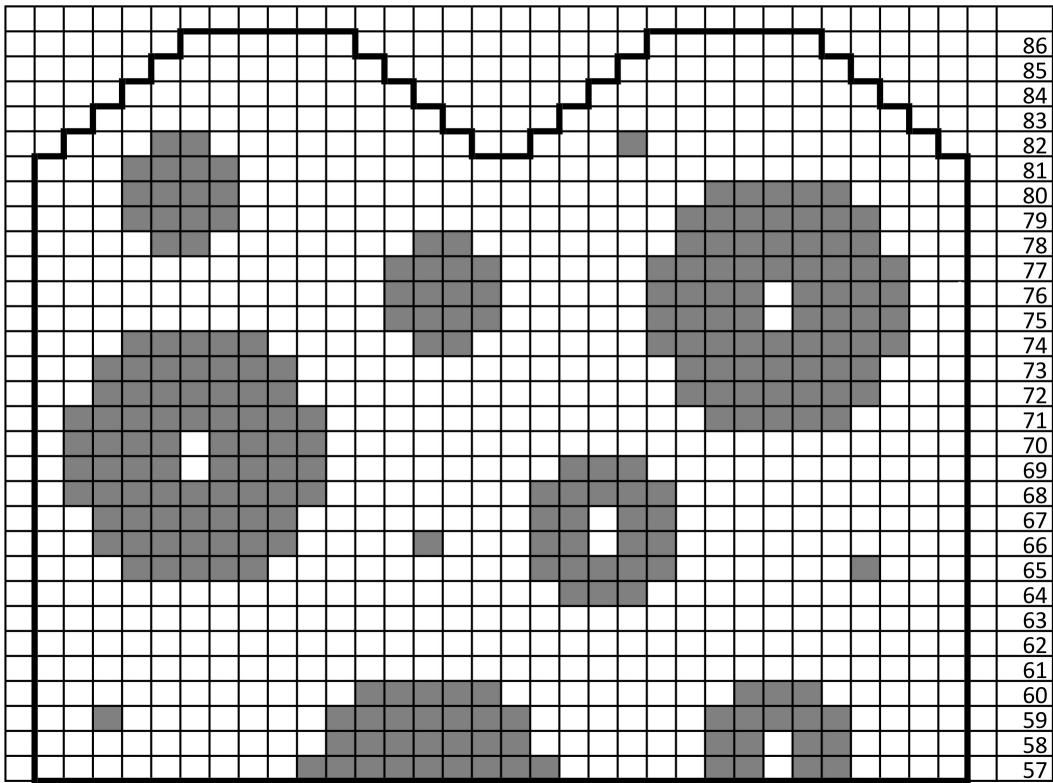
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Peasant Thumb Chart
