



Lights on Broadway Mittens

Size: Women's Medium (7.5" wide and 7.5" long with a 2" cuff) and Men's Medium (8.5" wide and 8" long with a 2" cuff)

Gauge: 10 stitches and 12 rows per inch (It is important to get gauge to get the stated size)

Supplies:

(yarn amounts are based on men's medium)

- 50g (about 231 yards) fingering yarn in dark color (I used Knit Picks Palette in Abyss Heather)
- 25g (about 115 yards) fingering yarn in yellow (I used Knit Picks Palette in Semolina)

- four size 1 double pointed needles or size needed to get gauge
- stitch marker
- scrap fingering yarn
- tapestry needle

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

M1 – make one stitch, direction doesn't matter

Ssk – slip two stitches and then knit them together

K2tog – knit two stitches together

Follow the chart for the color pattern and the written pattern for shaping.

Cuff:

W med (M med)

Cast on 74 (84) stitches. Divide between three needles. Join together to knit in the round placing a stitch marker between the last and first stitch to mark rows.

Row 1 – 19: k, p until end of row

Row 20 – 24: k

Hand:

Row 25: k37(42), m1, k37(42), m1 (76(86) stitches)

Row 26 – 55(57): k

Row 56(58):

Right hand: k5, k15(17) onto the scrap yarn, slip those 15(17) stitches back onto the left needle, k71(81)

Left hand: k20(21), k15(17) onto scrap yarn, slip those 15(17) stitches back onto the left needle, k58 (65)

Row 57 - 99(59 – 102): k

Row 100(103): ssk, k34 (39), k2tog, ssk, k34 (39), k2tog (72(82) stitches)

Row 101(104): k

Row 102(105): ssk, k32(37), k2tog, ssk, k32(37), k2tog (68(78) stitches)

Row 103(106): k

Row 104(107): ssk, k30(35), k2tog, ssk, k30(35), k2tog (64(74) stitches)
(Men's size only - Row 108: k)

Row 105(109): ssk, k28(33), k2tog, ssk, k28(33), k2tog (60(70) stitches)

Row 106(110): ssk, k26(31), k2tog, ssk, k26(31), k2tog (56(66) stitches)

Row 107(111): ssk, k24(29), k2tog, ssk, k24(29), k2tog (52(62) stitches)

Row 108(112): ssk, k22(27), k2tog, ssk, k22(27), k2tog (48(58) stitches)

Row 109(113): ssk, k20(25), k2tog, ssk, k20(25), k2tog (44(54) stitches)

Row 110(114): ssk, k18(23), k2tog, ssk, k18(23), k2tog (40(50) stitches)

Row 111(115): ssk, k16(21), k2tog, ssk, k16(21), k2tog (36(46) stitches)

Row 112(116): ssk, k14(19), k2tog, ssk, k14(19), k2tog (32(42) stitches)

Row 113(117): ssk, k12(17), k2tog, ssk, k12(17), k2tog (28(38) stitches)

Row 114(118): ssk, k10(15), k2tog, ssk, k10(15), k2tog (24(34) stitches)

Men's size only

Row 119: ssk, k13, k2tog, ssk, k13, k2tog (30 stitches)

Row 120, ssk, k11, k2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog (26 stitches)

Put the first 12(13) stitches on one needle and the second 12(13) on another.

Cut yarn leaving about a 10" – 12" tail. Seam top of mitten using Kitchener stitch.

Thumb:

Carefully remove scrap yarn putting the top stitches on one needle and the bottom stitches on another, 30(34) stitches. Divide between three needles. You'll be picking up stitches between the top and bottom to help prevent gaps.

Row 56(58):Right thumb: start at the bottom right, k15(17) pick up and k1, k15(17), pick up and k1, place stitch marker(32(36) stitches)

Left thumb: start at the bottom right, pick up and k1, k15(17), pick up and k1, k15(17), place stitch marker (32(36) stitches)

Row 57 – 82(59 – 83): k

Row 83(84): ssk, k12(14), k2tog, ssk, k12(14), k2tog (28(32) stitches)

(Men's size only: Row 85: k)

Row 84(86): ssk, k10(12), k2tog, ssk, k10(12), k2tog (24(28) stitches)

Row 85(87): ssk, k8(10), k2tog, ssk, k8(10), k2tog (20(24) stitches)

Row 86(88): ssk, k6(8), k2tog, ssk, k6(8), k2tog (16(20) stitches)

Row 87(89): ssk, k4(6), k2tog, ssk, k4(6), k2tog (12(16) stitches)

Row 88(90): ssk, k2(4), k2tog, ssk, k2(4), k2tog (8(12) stitches)

Men's size only

Row 91: ssk, k2, k2tog, ssk, k2, k2tog (8 stitches)

Put the first 4 stitches on one needle and the second four on another.

Cut the yarn leaving about an 8" – 10" tail. Seam the top of the thumb closed using Kitchener stitch.

Weave in ends

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
